



GB DECISIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

No formal decisions have been taken, however the following recommendations have been issued:

- 1) The Governing Board agreed that to tackle the overall needs related to the implementation of large scale demos, a dedicated person should be hired to build up and manage a joint procurement strategy. It was agreed to provide for such possibility in the AWP 2015, using the mechanism of public procurements.
- 2) The Governing Board agreed to contract an expert to analyse the impact of more supportive regulatory framework in transport on the FCH sector at large using the mechanism of public procurements in AWP 2015.
- 3) The Governing Board agreed that the EU Roadmap for roll-out of HRSs and FCEVs shall be added to the MAWP as an annex illustrating the vision of the industry. The AWP 2015 should provide for EU level support in coordination of these activities in form of procurement.
- 4) The Governing Board decided that the Stakeholder Forum 2015 shall take place in Brussels, to link the SF with the Programme Review Days and confirmed Mr Bernard Frois as coordinator of the SF 2015 organization committee.
- 5) The GB members agreed to set a Sherpa Group to elaborate a joint communication strategy.
