1. In the Tender Specifications, there is a requirement for two references. Is it possible to use a contracting authority as a reference?	<p>The Tender Specification do not set up any restrictions in terms of references (past relevant experience) other than what it is expressly stated in section 5.2 of this document.</p> <p><i>“(…)The project references indicated below consist in a list of relevant services provided in the past three years, with the sums, dates and clients, public or private, accompanied by statements issued by the clients.</i></p> <p><i>- Criterion A1: The tenderer must prove experience in the field of Information System support and assistance, as well as in IT infrastructure and network administration.</i></p> <p><i>Evidence A1: the tenderer must provide references for a minimum of 2 projects concerning different clients delivered in these fields in the last three years with a minimum value for each contract of € 500.000”.</i></p> <p>As a result, if the conditions mentioned in the text are complied with (minimum two project with a minimum value of 500.000 euros each delivered in the last three years from two different clients), no other conditions apply.</p> <p>There are no conditions applicable to the identity of a possible client used as reference.</p>
